

Sanzaemon Kobayashi is a Japanese calligrapher and has created the one and only unique Calligraphy on Woman's Body where woman's body is interpreted as the finest sheet of washi paper. Calligraphy on Woman's Body has opened up a new art form. His works are directly drawn on women's skin and express each person's own hope, wish, dream or message to someone dear to her as well as sadness, dilemma and worries about her injury or illness. A professional stylist coordinates outfit and makeup, and tops them up with fresh flowers. Finally, a professional photographer takes portraits. Every single artwork on display is one of a kind specially printed on a sheet of precious washi paper.



So Kobayashi is Sanzaemon's son and an oil painter.
